TRANSFER ADMISSION PROCEDURES/QUALIFICATIONS

- Application:
- It is suggested students make an appointment to discuss academic and career goals with an enrollment advisor before applying. An advisor can review transcripts at this appointment. These may be unofficial transcripts at this time.
 - Application may be obtained from OUKC or downloaded from www.ottawa.edu
 - \$55 nonrefundable application fee must be included with application.
 - Request official transcripts from all previous colleges or universities be sent directly to the OUKC Registrar by mail campus to campus. Faxed or hand-carried transcripts are not acceptable.
 - Application deadline: Rolling

International Students: Are accepted but need to work with the representative from the Ottawa University International Office to verify student status and funding availability. Contact Office of International Students at 1-800-755-5200.

Readmit Students: On approval of the OUKC Dean of Instruction.

Transfer Qualifications: No minimum GPA is required for admission but a cumulative GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale is required for graduation from the University.

ACT/SAT Scores: Not required for admission to this campus.

Transcript Evaluations: Transcript evaluation is a student service provided by the University.

TRANSFER CREDIT/GRADING POLICIES

- Application of Credit:
- Up to 80 hours of lower division course work will be accepted for most degrees.
- GPA Calculation:
- Calculation of GPA for the bachelor's degree includes grades from course work at OUKC as well as transfer credit.
- Pass/Fail:
- Accepted
- Repeat Policy:
- The most recent graded attempt of a course replaces the original grade in the grade point average computation.
- "D" Grades:
- Acceptable for general education courses only. Not acceptable for courses in major.
- Time Limit on Credit:
- No time limit on age of credit earned.
- Credit Given For:
- Experience-based learning, military experience, department proficiency exams (if on transcript as credit), independent study (if on transcript as credit), CLEP (accepted as part of lower division hours if on transcript, up to 80 hours) and PEP (accepted by ACE standards).
