TRANSFER ADMISSION PROCEDURES/QUALIFICATIONS

- Application:
- Application is available at www.park.edu/apply.
 - \$25 nonrefundable application fee must be paid before application is processed.
 - Request official transcripts from ALL previous post-secondary schools to be sent to the Office of Admissions.
- International Students:
- Application fee is \$75. Contact the Department of International Student Services at (816) 584-6834 for additional information/documents required, or go to www.park.edu/admissions/international.aspx.
- Readmit Students:
- Students who want to be readmitted must fill out an Application for Readmission. Contact the Office of Admissions to obtain this form.
- Transfer Qualifications:
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale for admission to the university. Admission GPA is calculated based on **all** previous college course work.
 - Some degree programs require higher cumulative GPA's for admission into the department (Education, Athletic Training, Social Work).
 - Students who have earned fewer than 12 hours will need to submit high school transcripts and ACT scores, and meet admission standards for high school students as outlined in the Park University catalog.
- ACT/SAT Scores:
- Not required for admission to the University for transfer students with 12 or more credit hours. Some programs may require these test scores.
- Transcript Evaluation:
- An official evaluation is available at the time of registration/advising. For additional information contact the Office of Admissions at (816) 584-6218.
- Campus Visits:
- Available first Saturday of the month (October thru April). If Saturdays aren't an option, students may call the Office of Admissions to set up a visit during the week.

TUITION/FEES/EXPENSES FOR THE 2009-2010 ACADEMIC YEAR

- Tuition and Fees:
- \$298 per credit hour.
 - This is a flat rate. Everyone pays the same per credit hour. This charge doesn't include lab or studio fees.
- Room and Board:
- \$7,120 per year dependent on hall. Based on double occupancy. Single rooms may be available at a higher rate.
- Books:
- Cost can vary.
- Additional Expenses: Miscellaneous expenses for travel, social activities, extra meals, etc., can vary depending on the student.
