- Academic good standing; minimum cumulative grade point average of at least 2.0

PLEASE NOTE: Students must also apply and be admitted into the School of Nursing. Please contact the School of Nursing for their admission requirements.

REQUIREMENTS FOR BACHELOR'S DEGREE:

- Minimum of 124 semester hours of credit
- Minimum of 60 semester hours from Washburn or a four-year college or university; at least 30 hours must be completed through Washburn
- Minimum of 45 semester hours of credit from courses at the upper division level
- Minimum of 84 graded hours
- Grade of C or better in courses counting towards the university requirements and toward the major
