TRANSFER ADMISSION PROCEDURES/QUALIFICATIONS

Application:

- Students need to make an appointment to attend an information meeting or an individual appointment with a program representative.
- Applications are available online at www.bakeru.edu or at the information meeting.
- \$45.00 nonrefundable application fee must be submitted with the application.
- Completion of the Request for Transcript forms for ALL regionally accredited schools attended will allow the institution to send off for your transcripts. This form is available online at www.bakeru.edu.

International Students:

- All international students should apply for admission as above.
- Minimum score on the TOEFL is 600 on the paper test, 250 on the computer-based test or 100 for the Internet-based test.

Transfer Qualifications:

Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale for admission to the university. Admission GPA is calculated by averaging together all courses taken at all institutions regardless of whether or not it is applicable to a degree.

ACT/SAT Scores:

Not required for admission to Baker University - SPGS unless the student is transferring less than 12 credit hours and has been home-schooled.

Transcript Evaluation:

Students who have been admitted to Baker University - SPGS receive an official credit evaluation.

TRANSFER CREDIT/GRADING POLICIES

- Application of Credit:
- Students are only required to complete the bachelor level major courses at Baker University - SPGS, which is a total of 41 credits.
 - If the student has earned an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree from a regionally accredited institution, the 30 credit general education requirement is waived.
 - If a student does not have an earned Associate degree in Arts or Sciences, transfer credit is evaluated on a course-by-course basis. Students will be required to meet Baker University - SPGS 30 credit hour general education requirement.
- GPA Calculation:
- Calculation of GPA for the bachelor's degree includes all grades from course work completed at Baker University - SPGS as well as transfer credit.
- Pass/Fail:
- Accepted
- Repeat Policy:
- For repeated courses, both courses will appear on the transcript. Only the grade of the subsequent course will apply to the cumulative GPA. If the course is repeated a second time, both of the repeated grades will apply to the cumulative GPA.
- "D" Grades:
- Courses with a grade of "D" will not transfer.
- Time Limit on Credit:
- No time limit on age of credit earned.
- Credit Given For:
- Experience-based learning, military experience, departmental proficiency exams (if on transcript as credit), independent study (if on transcript as credit), CLEP, DANTES and Advanced Placement tests only with a copy of official transcript from Educational Testing Service.
