TRANSFER ADMISSION PROCEDURES/QUALIFICATIONS

- Application:
- Online application can be found at www.fhsu.edu/admissions/information/application.shtml.
 - Application fee: \$30 non-refundable.
 - Request official transcripts from all previous colleges or universities to be sent to the FHSU Registrar's Office at 600 Park Street, Hays, KS 67601.
 - Application deadline: Fall – June 1, Spring – October 1.

- International Students:
- International student application fee is \$50. See www.fhsu.edu/international/prospective.shtml for additional information.
- Readmit Students:
- Students must reapply if they have been out of school more than one semester. If they have attended FHSU at any time, no application fee is required.
- Academic Reinstatement:
- Students academically suspended from the university for poor scholarship will be provided the right to appeal following their first academic suspension. Students who have been suspended before will not be provided the right to appeal. They will be required to lay out for a period of at least one semester during which they should reconsider and re-evaluate their plans. Students enrolling at another school during their period of suspension from the University will be expected to achieve a minimum of a C average at that school. An official transcript from other institutions must be sent to the Office of the Registrar. Each application will be considered on its own merits by the Academic Reinstatement Board. Reinstatement is not automatic. An application for Academic Reinstatement can be found online at www.fhsu.edu/aace/probationsuspension.shtml.
 - Students who have been academically dismissed from the University cannot be reinstated unless they have taken courses at a regionally accredited institution to transfer in to raise their cumulative GPA to 2.00 or higher. An official transcript from other institutions must be sent to the Office of the Registrar.
- Transfer Qualifications:
- Student acceptance is based on a "C" average as determined by FHSU.
 - Applicants less than 21 years of age who have earned less than 24 hours with at least a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 must meet the high school graduates' qualified admission requirements. Out-of-state transfers with less than 24 credit hours must have a 2.5 GPA and meet the high school graduates' minimum admission requirements.
- ACT/SAT Scores:
- Not required for admission to the University for transfer students with 24 or more credit hours.
- Transcript Evaluations:
- Degree summaries are available for admitted students.
- Campus Visits:

Undergraduate Tuition and Fees:

On Campus:

- Kansas Resident: \$125.40/credit hour
- Contiguous State Resident (Missouri, Nebraska, Oklahoma and Colorado): \$174.50/credit hour
- Non-Resident: \$397.15/credit hour

Room and Board (per year):

- Application Fee: \$35 non-refundable
- Residence Halls: Double room with open access meal plan \$6,560
- Wooster Place Apartments: One-Bedroom \$480/mo plus electricity
Two-Bedroom \$558/mo plus electricity
- Stadium Place Apartments: Two-Bedroom \$469/mo plus share of electricity & \$15 monthly water charge
Four-Bedroom \$418/mo plus share of electricity & \$15 monthly water charge
- Off-campus: Varies

FINANCIAL AID/SCHOLARSHIPS

Application Deadline:

- Financial Aid: March 15 (priority)
- Scholarships: December 15 (priority), February 15 (final)

Special Requirements:

- College Transcripts. ACT and high school transcripts required if transferring in with less than 24 credit hours.

Scholarship Application:

- Complete the online scholarship application at www.fhsu.edu/scholarship/.

Transfer Scholarship:

- Students transferring with a 3.0 GPA or better and 45 accumulated credit hours qualify to apply for the \$1000 transfer scholarship. Applicants must submit the scholarship application online.

TRANSFER CREDIT/GRADING POLICIES

Application of Credit:

- At least 60 semester hours of credit must be earned from an accredited, baccalaureate degree-granting institution, and a minimum of 30 hours earned at FHSU.
- Transfer credits toward major requirements is determined by each major department.
- General Education credits are evaluated by the Registrar's Office.

GPA Calculation:

- Calculation of GPA will include acceptable transfer hours and course work from Fort Hays State University.

Pass/Fail:

- Not accepted for general education courses, courses in the major, minor cognates, or minor.

Repeat Policy:

- Courses may be repeated. All grades will remain on the student's transcript and the grade for the last enrollment in the course will be used in determining grade points and meeting degree requirements. The grade in the course being repeated will also contain a notation RP (Repeated) on the transcript.

"D" Grades:

- A "D" is accepted in transferable courses; however, the major department determines if "D" grades are applied toward a specific degree.

Time Limit on Credit:

- No time limit on age of credit earned.

Credit Given For:

- Military experience, department proficiency exams, independent study and CLEP.
