**Doctor of Chiropractic Degree**

- ❖ Cleveland Chiropractic College requires at least \*90 semester hours of college credit, 24 of which must be basic science hours, prior to entrance. Credits in excess of 90 hours will also be used in the computation of a student's cumulative grade point average, which must be at least a 2.5 on a 4.0 scale for all required courses for consideration. Transcripts are evaluated on an individual basis. Also, certain physical requirements are deemed essential for participation in and completion of all phases of classroom, lab and clinical activities. Courses over five years old must be approved by Cleveland Chiropractic College.
- ❖ Completion of a bachelor's degree is strongly recommended. Cleveland Chiropractic offers a B.S. in Human Biology.
