



- ❖ A minimum of 64 semester hours must be completed at a four-year institution. The final thirty (30) hours must be completed at Avila University. A minimum GPA of 2.0 (C) is required for graduation in all work attempted, including transfer credits. At least 12 upper-division hours in the major must be completed at Avila. All upper-division courses in the major must have a minimum grade of C. All courses specifically required for the major must be completed with a grade of C or higher.
- ❖ Credit/No Credit Policy: No major courses specifically required for the major may be taken CR/NC. No more than 12 hours of the CR/NC grade option are applied toward an Avila Degree. See Avila catalog for policy.
- ❖ Only one repeat of a business or economics course by a business major is permitted.

III. LEVEL III — APPLICATIONS AND INTEGRATION (NO TWO-YEAR COLLEGE EQUIVALENT FOR LEVEL III)

Interdisciplinary courses that cross disciplines from any two or more areas of the university and taught at the 310 level or above. They reflect the unique talents and interests of the faculty, use primary sources, address university outcomes and emphasize higher level thinking skills. Students may register for Level III courses only after completing Level I requirements and 15 credit hours of Level II requirements.

IV. LEVEL IV — THE EDUCATED PERSON IN SOCIETY (NO TWO-YEAR COLLEGE EQUIVALENT FOR LEVEL IV)

This is the capstone course for the Core Curriculum. In this course students will address a theme selected by the faculty, interact with students from various disciplines, experience multiple approaches to an issue and be challenged to integrate prior knowledge.

All of the following courses (VI and VII) must have a minimum grade of "C".
