



- ❖ A minimum of 64 semester hours must be completed at a four-year institution. The final thirty (30) hours must be completed at Avila University.
- ❖ A minimum GPA of 2.0 (C) is required for graduation in all work attempted, including transfer credits. At least 12 upper-division hours in the major must be completed at Avila.
- ❖ All upper-division courses in the major must have a minimum grade of C. All courses specifically required for the major must be completed with a grade of C or better.
