TRANSFER ADMISSION PROCEDURES/QUALIFICATIONS

Application:

- Application packet is available in the Avila Office of Admissions or may be completed online at [www.avila.edu](http://www.avila.edu).
- There is no application fee if you apply online.
- Request official transcripts from all previous colleges or universities to be sent directly to the Avila Office of Admissions by mail.
- Application deadline: Rolling.

International Students:

- See International student website at [www.avila.edu/international](http://www.avila.edu/international).

Readmit Students:

- Readmission applies to any student who has completed at least one hour of credit at Avila and has missed two semesters or more.
- Students should submit an application for admission form available from the Avila Office of Admissions or online.
- Re-admit students must be in good standing with Avila.
- Must have at least a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or greater in all college work attempted since leaving Avila.

Transfer Qualifications:

- Students transferring with 24 or more of non-developmental credit hours and a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale will be considered for admission. Students transferring fewer than 24 hours must also provide high school transcript for consideration.
- All non-developmental courses on college transcripts will be included in the admission GPA computation.

ACT/SAT Scores:

- ACT or SAT scores are not required for transfer students.

Transcript Evaluations:

- Official evaluation is not made until all official transcripts are received.

Early Registration:

- Early registration is advised. Contact the Office of Admissions for dates.

Campus Visits:

- Campus visits are required for certain scholarships and are available upon request through the Avila Office of Admissions.

<u>Special Requirements:</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• FAFSA and Avila application for admission. Avila's FAFSA code is #002449.</li> </ul>
<u>Transfer Scholarships:</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Awards based on combination of academic achievement, financial need, performance ability or athletic ability.</li> </ul>

TRANSFER CREDIT/GRADING POLICIES
----------------------------------

<u>Application of Credit:</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Minimum number of hours required toward a degree is 64 hours from four-year colleges.</li> <li>• Application of transfer credit toward degree requirements is determined by the registrar.</li> </ul>
<u>GPA Calculation:</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Grades are transferred along with courses and count in the cumulative GPA.</li> </ul>
<u>CR/NC:</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Varies by department for general education courses. Not acceptable for some major courses.</li> </ul>
<u>Retake Policy:</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The last repetition of a course replaces the original grade(s) in the grade point average computation.</li> </ul>
<u>"D" Grades:</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Acceptable in some general education courses (unless major specifies a "C" or better), not for courses in the major, especially if courses are numbered 310 or above.</li> </ul>
<u>Time Limit on Credit:</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Credits earned more than 15 years ago will be accepted toward a degree but not toward major/minor requirements without written approval of the academic advisor, department chairperson, and academic dean.</li> </ul>
<u>Credit Given for:</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Experience based education, military experience, department proficiency exams, independent study (or internship) and CLEP.</li> </ul>
