



- ❖ **These requirements are effective for all students whose first enrollment in an accredited college or university occurs in the fall of 2009 or later.**
- ❖ General Education core requirements are common to all degrees regardless of major. However, there are some requirements unique to specific majors. Students majoring in **business, elementary education, secondary education** or **nursing** should refer to the transfer programs for those specific majors. Art majors and Information Resource majors should refer to the General Education Requirements in the Emporia State Catalog for specific course selection.
- ❖ At least 60 semester hours must be earned from a four-year college or university, 30 of those hours at Emporia State University. At least 45 semester hours must be earned in junior and senior level courses.
