



❖ **These requirements are effective for students whose first enrollment in an accredited college or university occurs in Fall 2009 or later.**

In order to apply either fall or spring semesters to the Education Program, students must have completed the following:

- ❖ Have at least junior level standing with 60 or more semester hours before Phase I courses begin.
- ❖ Must obtain health clearance, please see Emporia State advisor for required forms and additional information.
- ❖ **Have minimum 2.75 GPA on 35-hour core curriculum noted below with (+) and 2.5 minimum cumulative GPA. A minimum grade of "C" is required for courses noted below with (\*).**
- ❖ Earn minimum PPST scores: 172 math, 173 reading, 172 writing or CAAP scores of 55 math, 57 reading, sliding scale writing.
- ❖ Have completed minimum of 100 hours of either paid or voluntary work experience in advocacy roles with preschool through grade 12 students which required being responsible for the health, safety, and physical and emotional well-being of the children and adolescents supervised.
- ❖ Students should check the Emporia State catalog for selection of specific general education courses required for their teaching field.
