TRANSFER ADMISSION PROCEDURES/QUALIFICATIONS

Application:

- Applications are available in the JCCC Student Center, 2nd floor, or can be requested from Emporia State Office of Admissions.
- Apply online or download an application at www.emporia.edu/admissions. \$30 nonrefundable application fee must be mailed with the application. Check, money order or credit card is accepted.
- Request official transcripts from all previous colleges or universities to be sent directly to the Emporia State Office of Admissions by mail: 1200 Commercial, Box 4034, Emporia, KS 66801.
- Application deadline: Rolling

International Students:

- Must apply 2 months prior to intended entry date using international student application. \$50 application fee. See www.emporia.edu/oie/ for application form and details.

Readmit Students:

- A readmission application must be filled out and returned to the Registration Office if an undergraduate is returning to ESU after being absent for one semester or more. There is no fee for being readmitted.
- Must submit an official transcript from each institution attended since leaving ESU.
- Readmit application is available online at www.emporia.edu/regist/enroll/readmit.htm.

Transfer Qualifications:

- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale on 24 or more transferable hours for admission to the University. Admission GPA is calculated based on all previous transferable college course work, completed after high school graduation.
- Some programs of study require higher GPA's. For specific program requirements see the Emporia State catalog at www.emporia.edu/regist/catalog.
- Transfer applicants who have earned less than 24 hours of transfer credit must also submit an official high school transcript showing graduation date and ACT results.

ACT/SAT Scores:

- Not required for admission to the University for transfer students with 24 or more transferable credit hours or 21 years of age or older. Some programs may require these test scores.

Qualified Admissions:

- Effective Fall 2001, transfer students with fewer than 24 transferable credit hours must meet the conditions for high school graduates as shown in the Emporia State catalog and achieve a cumulative college GPA of 2.0.

Transcript Evaluations:

- Official evaluation is part of the admission procedure.

- Admitted transfer students are invited to SWARM, ESU's enrollment program. Sign up online at www.emporia.edu/admissions/SWARM. Campus visits are available daily, Monday-Friday from 10:30 a.m.-2:30 p.m., by appointment excluding holidays. Special Saturday visit days are announced each semester. Special transfer visit days are announced each semester.

	<u>NEARR to Kansas*</u> \$6,048 (10 hours or more/sem) *NEARR tuition is for students whose primary residence is Colorado, Nebraska, Missouri, Oklahoma or Texas.	
<u>Room and Board:</u>	• Residence Halls: \$6,146 (estimated) + \$45 application fee and \$100 assignment payment. Information for off-campus living is available through the ESU Office of Admissions.	
<u>Books/Supplies:</u>	\$450 (approximately) per semester.	
<u>Additional Expenses:</u>	Miscellaneous living expenses for travel, social activities, parking permit, extra meals, etc., vary depending on the student.

TRANSFER CREDIT/GRADING POLICIES

<u>Application of Credit:</u>	• At least 60 hours of course work must be completed at four-year schools. • A minimum of 30 hours must be earned at ESU. • Application of transfer credit toward degree requirements is determined by each major division.
<u>GPA Calculation:</u>	• Calculation of GPA for the bachelor's degree includes grades from course work completed at Emporia State and transfer credit.
<u>Pass/Fail:</u>	• Not acceptable for general education courses or courses in the major.
<u>Repeat Policy:</u>	• The cumulative GPA calculation procedure for repeated course work is as follows: All grades will remain on the student's transcript, but only the last grade will be used in determining grade point averages, and only the course hours in one course may apply toward the degree. This policy applies regardless of where the course was originally taken or repeated. (Definition of Terms: Repeated course work is course work with the same course number, title and credit hours, or course work which the department chair offering that course determines is the equivalent course.)
<u>"D" Grades:</u>	• Acceptable in general education courses except Composition I and II. Acceptability for course work in the major depends on the major. See transfer sheets for specific majors.
<u>Time Limit on Credit:</u>	• No time limit on age of credit earned.
<u>Credit Given For:</u>	• Experienced based education (through test-out procedures), military experience, department proficiency exams, College Board Advanced Placement (CEEB), CLEP and PEP. See www.emporia.edu/regist/analyst/crexam.htm for details.
