The Associate of Arts degree (A.A.) at JCCC is a general transfer degree and partners well with the first two years of most bachelor degree programs. Students pursuing the A.A. may select courses that satisfy both the A.A. degree requirements and lower division requirements for a bachelor's degree at four-year institutions.

Golf Course Management Specialization

This program is designed to prepare the next generation of golf course superintendents and managers. The unique curriculum combines courses in business, communications, hospitality and turf management, along with two internships.

Sports Turf Operations Management Specialization

This option prepares students for rewarding careers with professional sports organizations, school districts, colleges and university grounds departments, and municipal park and recreation departments.

- This degree requires a minimum of 130 credit hours.
A maximum of half of the 130 total credits required for this degree may be transferred to K-State from a community college.
All K-State students are required to complete 18 hours of university general education courses.

- Students should consult with a JCCC counselor when planning their transfer course work, particularly in the areas of humanities, social sciences and natural sciences to allow for the university general education course work that must be taken at K-State.
