



Effective Fall 2006, the Bachelor of Architecture degree will be replaced with the Master of Architecture degree at KU. This change reflects a dominant trend in architectural education involving the replacement of the B.Arch. with the M.Arch.

- ❖ The Master of Architecture degree (180 credit hours) is designed to be completed in five years, with one summer of academic work (study abroad or an internship with a firm following the fourth year of study). Students admitted to the M.Arch. pay tuition at the undergraduate rate for all but 30 credit hours, which are assessed at the graduate tuition rate.
❖ Transfer students planning to apply to the KU School of Architecture and Urban Planning should contact Michael Swann (see contact information above) while at JCCC, as soon as possible.
❖ Applications for admission for transfer students must be received by the KU School of Architecture and Urban Planning by October 1 (spring admission) and February 1 (fall and summer admission).
❖ Transfer students are admitted on a very selective basis, if space is available, if they have grades of C or better in one three-hour math course, one four-hour physics course with laboratory, and have a minimum overall grade point average of 3.5.
❖ Students who wish to transfer graphics or design courses to the professional degrees may do so only upon submission of a portfolio of work done in such courses. Placement in the professional curricula will be based upon completed coursework and a review of the comprehensive portfolio of prior work in architecturally-oriented courses. Advanced studio placement is on a space-available basis. Please visit the school's website for guidelines on portfolio reviews (www.saud.ku.edu).
❖ Credit/No Credit - Acceptable for general education courses; not for ARCH courses.

RECOMMENDED ONE-YEAR PROGRAM AT JCCC

The curriculum below meets requirements for the one-year JCCC architecture transfer program to the five-year Master of Architecture degree at the University of Kansas School of Architecture and Urban Planning starting in the fall of 2006. This list is a suggested sequence of courses. These courses may be taken at any time; however, students should complete these courses before transferring to KU to stay on track with the first-year
