Health & Physical Education Teacher Licensure (PK-12)

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- ❖ Students may enter the School of Education by meeting the admission requirements. In addition to the minimum 2.5 GPA, program admission is based on performance in core courses, academic preparation for the major and the number of students that each program can admit.
- ❖ Students are selected once a year in the spring for fall semester admission to the Health and Physical Education Teacher Licensure Program.
- ❖ Complete an application and provide accompanying information to the Welcome Center, 208 J.R. Pearson Hall. All materials are due on February 1. Students are notified of decisions in writing on or before April 1.
- ❖ Applicants must have completed at least 45 hours by the time of application and at least 50 hours by the time of admission. Courses indicated (*) must be included among the 45 hours completed before the application deadline with a minimum GPA of 2.75. No grade lower than C is acceptable in English, mathematics or communication studies.
- ❖ A student must pass all three sections of the Pre-Professional Skills Test (PPST) before submitting application materials. Passing scores are 172 in Math, 173 in Reading and 172 in Writing.
- ❖ Students are strongly advised to take all of the courses listed below prior to Block I.
- ❖ Minimum 126-127 hours required for the degree.
