TRANSFER ADMISSION PROCEDURES/QUALIFICATIONS

- Application:
- Admissions committee makes admission decision after reviewing the application and credentials.
 - Reference letters are not needed.
 - Application for Admission deadline is as space permits.
- ACT/SAT Scores:
- ACT or SAT is not required with 24 hours of completed college coursework.
- Early Registration:
- Early registration or visitations on campus for transfer students. Visits begin mid-October for spring entry and mid-March for fall entry.
- Campus Visits:
- Contact the Admissions Office for individual appointments.

TUITION/FEES/EXPENSES FOR THE 2010-2011 ACADEMIC YEAR

Undergraduate Tuition: \$26,450 (per year, enrolled in 12-18 hours per semester)

Academic Scholarships: Average between \$7000 – \$12,500

Financial Aid: Package including academic awards = \$17,500.

Fees: Approximately \$940 full-time, \$250 part-time

Room and Board: \$7,090 – \$7,890

Books: \$800/yr.

Estimated Additional Expenses: \$650

Cost per Credit Hour: Daytime: \$882 per credit hour (enrolled in 1-11 hours)

Evening: \$441 per credit hour (enrolled in 1-11 hours)

FINANCIAL AID/SCHOLARSHIPS

- Application Deadline:
- February 15 (suggested date).
- Transfer Scholarships:
- Merit scholarships are awarded based on GPA:
 - 3.6 - 4.0: Distinguished Scholar - \$9,000/year
 - 3.3 - 3.59: Founder's Scholarship - \$7,500/year
 - 3.0 - 3.29: Jesuit Opportunity Scholarship - \$5,500/year
 - Phi Theta Kappa membership - \$2,000/year. Proof of membership required.
 - Greater KC Community College Scholarship - \$1,500. Completion of 12 credit hours and minimum 3.0 GPA.

TRANSFER CREDIT/GRADING POLICIES

- Application of Credit:
- Associate of Arts Degree does not meet General Education requirements. Transfer credit is evaluated on a course by course basis.
 - There is no Physical Education requirement.
 - 64 maximum number of hours accepted from JCCC
- GPA Required:
- Normally the JCCC GPA is kept separate; however, for honors purposes at graduation, the JCCC GPA may be averaged in if the Rockhurst GPA is 3.5 and above.
- Pass/Fail:
- Accepted in General Education and in Major courses provided the Pass is based on “C” or better grades.
- “D” Grades:
- Not accepted in General Education or Major courses.
- Time Limit on Credit:
- No time limit.
