TRANSFER ADMISSION PROCEDURES/QUALIFICATIONS

- Application:
- GPA required (on 4.0 system) 2.00; 2.25 for Business Administration, 2.5 for Education.
 - Reference letters are not needed.
- ACT/SAT Scores:
- Either ACT or SAT is required if the student is 21 years of age or less, degree-bound and transferring to WSU with fewer than 24 hours.
- Campus Visits:
- Visitations are highly recommended and are available Monday and Friday at 9:45 a.m. and 12:45 p.m.; Tuesday at 9:45 a.m.; Thursday at 12:45 p.m.

TUITION/FEES/EXPENSES FOR THE 2010-2011 ACADEMIC YEAR

- Undergraduate Tuition and Fees: \$6,000 (Kansas resident - 15 hours/semester); \$12,800 (Non-resident - 15 hours/semester)
- Room and Board: Approximately \$6,000 with a 19-meal plan (includes \$35 non-refundable application fee)
- Books: \$900 (approximately) per academic year.
- Estimated Additional Expenses: \$2,400 (personal expense and transportation)
- Cost per Credit Hour: \$191 (Kansas resident); \$420 (Non-resident)

FINANCIAL AID/SCHOLARSHIPS

- Special Requirements:
- Must apply with FAFSA – March 15 priority date.
- Transfer Scholarships:
- Transfer scholarships are available to students with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher. The applicant must be fully admitted to WSU to be considered. The scholarship amount is \$1,500 to \$2,000 for one year (Fall/Spring) only. An activity chart and personal statement are also required.

TRANSFER CREDIT/GRADING POLICIES

- Application of Credit:
- There is no Physical Education requirement.
 - There is no maximum number of hours accepted, but students must complete 60 hours at 4-year schools, 45 of which must be upper division (junior/senior level).
- GPA Required:
- JCCC GPA is averaged in.
- Pass/Fail:
- Accepted in General Education courses.
- “D” Grades:
- Accepted in General Education courses (except Basic Skills classes: English, Communication and Math, and grade requirements of the degree-granting college)
- Time Limit on Credit:
- May or may not be accepted in Major (depending on policy of degree-granting college and departments)
- Credit Given For:
- No time limit.
- CLEP Policy:
- Transferable (except for ENGL 101) if WSU required scores are achieved.
